The **Earth Spirit Dolls** show will be organized and hung by the Apronistas. Hanging will take place Monday, **March 2, 2015**, time and place to deliver work to be announced.

Opening Reception will be Friday, March 6, 2015. Show will come down March 28 or 29. Off Center will take 30% of the proceeds of sales. All dolls will be priced at \$15, thus Rainbow can "earn" \$10 for each doll sold and we would like to fill the wall with at least 100 dolls of a size eight inches or less. All dolls in this size range will be accepted, so here's a chance to get creative, make as many small dolls as you wish and help our organization get funds for future shows.

March 14: 11-1:30 at OFFCenter. Rainbow Artists will present a Spirit Doll Making Workshop. The workshop will demonstrate methods for creating small imaginative dolls from natural materials, branches, seeds, grasses, found objects and fabric. All materials will be provided for this free creative event and dolls created can be exhibited in OFFCenter's Earth Day exhibit during the month of April. Join us to bring to life your own spirit doll. This workshop is in conjunction with "A Wall of Dolls", earth spirit figures and fetishes, a Rainbow exhibit partnering with Women and Creativity 2015 and taking place at Off Center Arts, March 6-28.
