Joan Fenicle will moderate a discussion on "How Mundane Routines Produce Creative Magic". There will also be an art book swap and give away during the break. This was inspired by an article in 99u.com, the premise of which was:

"By repeating the same routine every day, these creators are effectively hypnotizing themselves, deliberately altering their state of consciousness in order to access the "deeper state of mind" that allows them to work their creative magic. The different elements of the routine become associated with this creative state of mind, so that they can re-enter it by simply repeating the steps of the routine.

If you want to develop your ability to enter the creative zone at will, you should know that there are three conditions for an effective hypnotic trigger:

- 1. **Uniqueness** it should be something (or a combination of things) you don't associate with other activities, otherwise the effect will be diluted.
- 2. **Emotional intensity** the kind you experience when you're really immersed in creative work.
- 3. **Repetition** the more times you experience the unique trigger in association with the emotions, the stronger the association becomes".
